How to Get to Konya

Flying is the best way to get to Konya. Domestic flights are reasonably priced and save a lot of time. Such other kinds of transportation as high-speed trains and coaches are also accessible once you get to Istanbul, Turkey.

Transportation from Konya Airport to City Center

Konya Airport is located at Selçuklu. The city center is 16 km from Konya Airport. You can reach the city center from the airport via Havaş shuttles, cabs, or renting a car. The Havaş bus costs 24 Turkish liras and takes 30 minutes to travel. Havaş buses run according to airplane arrival and departure hours, and the same service may be used to return to Konya Airport from the city center. 45 minutes before the flight departures, Havaş buses depart from Konya Ant Meydan Square.

Transportation from City Center to NEU Office of International Affairs

Necmettin Erbakan University's Office of International Affairs is located at Meram 15 Temmuz Campus. You can reach the Office from the city center via buses 3, 4 or 10.

2. Watch the Whirling Dervishes,
3. Have a day trip to the Neolithic Site of Çatalhöyük,
4. Have a stroll on Alaeddin Tepe, and also at Mevlana Square,
5. Visit Konya's important mosques like Aziziye Mosque and Ince Minare,
6. Explore the village of Sille, and visit St. Helena's Church,
7. Visit Konya Tropical Butterfly Garden and Kyoto Japon Park,
8. Have a day trip to Tuz Lake,



What and where to eat?

You can try such delicious dishes of Turkish food.

1. *Etliekmek*- a kind of pizza made of minced meat with line, handmade thin paste and brown flour.
2. Try kebaps- Tirit, a kind of kebab with a lot of melted

butter and yogurt sauce, and Tandır, lamb or mutton slowly cooked in stone oven with its own fat in copper trays.

3. Also, try soup houses for those legendary soups like Arabaşı soup of the Seljuk cuisine, okra soup, and yoghurt soup.

4. Sweeten your stomach with Konya's Sac Dessert with kaymak [cream].
